

RII20920 CERTIFICATE II IN DRILLING OPERATIONS

Course overview

RII20920 Certificate II in Drilling Operations reflects the role of offsidors working within the drilling industry. It is an entry-level qualification designed for individuals undertaking routine drilling tasks under supervision in real workplace environments.

Workplace requirement

Students must be employed in, or have access to, a suitable drilling workplace. Practical tasks are completed on the job using real equipment, site procedures and operational conditions. ACA Training does not deliver this qualification in a simulated or classroom-only environment.

Delivery and assessment

Delivery is self-paced and supported by the ACA Training App, available on iOS and Android devices. Students complete theory questions, workplace tasks and evidence uploads in the app, with assessor review and feedback. There are no classroom sessions.

What participants will learn

- Site setup and pack up
- Pre-start inspections
- Hazard identification and risk control
- Handling and loading equipment
- Applying safety and environmental procedures
- Supporting drilling processes

Duration, structure and completion

Nominal duration is 9 to 12 months, depending on workplace exposure and experience. The qualification consists of 8 core units and 4 elective units. To complete, students must meet the qualification requirements, complete app activities, provide required workplace evidence and be assessed as satisfactory.
